LEGACY FREIGHT OPTIONS

Maintaining an effective supply chain from the Far East and Indian sub-continent has always been challenging

- Slow Sea Freight
- Often Expensive Direct Air
- Deferred Air – Transit Cargo
- Variable and sometimes unreliable service at transshipment points
- Deferred Air- insecure/loose cargo
- Peak Congestion at Origin

Most if not all air freight is distressed ocean freight – with no alternative but to send it by air due to many different reasons, but what questions should be considered?

- Is it urgent but not that urgent?
- Do we really need a direct air service?
- Are there budgetary restraints?
- Is the consignment precious or delicate and loose cargo is a risk?

OUR TRANSHIPMENT HUBS



- Each hub, is in a secure, bonded, dedicated freight centre within airport parameters
- All goods are transferred to airline pallets, providing an additional level of security and protecting cargo further during the air leg
- Because the dwell time at our transshipment hubs is only 2 - 3 days, our services can be significantly faster than deferred air services

- No special documentation requirements – vendors still to produce documents for an Ocean Export
